Rules

The rules for the Williams County Fair King/Queen contest 2018 are as follows. If for any reason the following rules are broken, the King/Queen will surrender his/her crown and title to the First Runner-up. **These are Williams County Ag. Society rules for the (King/QUEEN) *** Ohio Fair Manager Association rules to follow: Go to: www.wcofair.com and www.OFMA.org for more information (Queen Only).**

1. Each contestant must be a resident of Williams County, between the ages of 16-18 years old as of January 1st of current year, not married, not have been married, not have a child, not have fathered a child, not have mothered a child, not be pregnant. There will be no consumption of any illegal substances (alcohol, drugs, etc.), no arrests of any illegal wrong or par-taken in any illegal activities. No person may succeed himself or herself.
2. Each contestant must have contributed to the growth of the Williams County Fair (example: participant, exhibitor, worker, etc.).
3. All contestants are encouraged to attend various county activities and events prior to the Williams County Fair assigned by pageant Directors.
4. All contestants, should they be named the **2018 Williams County Fair King/Queen** are encouraged to attend various county activities and events throughout the following year to represent **Williams County Fair**. If for any reason a contestant cannot accept this responsibility, he/she should not compete.
5. The Williams County Fair King/Queen and attendants will be expected to participate in the scheduled Fair events and activities for the remainder of this Fair. In case of a serious illness or injury, the First Runner-up shall assume the duties of the King/Queen until he/she is able to comply.
6. The Williams County Fair King/Queen and two Runners-up will be determined through an interview session based upon:
 - a. Activities – 50 points
 - b. Poise, Personality & Personal Appearance – 40 points
 - c. Essay of 200-400 words – 25 points
Topic: What are your career goals and what role has Fair experiences played in achieving this?
 - d. Questions – 60 points
 - e. Entry application – 25 points
 - f. **FINAL QUESTION** –will take place on Saturday, September 8th @ Williams County Fair. 50 points

Total-----250 points

7. The "2018 WILLIAMS COUNTY FAIR KING/QUEEN" will be crowned:
on Saturday, September 8th. At 5:00 p.m. North of the Gillette Building @ FREE STAGE AREA.
8. Each contestant's dress code will be semi-formal to formal attire.
9. **Mandatory** for Queen to compete at the state contest in **January 2018 during the OFMA convention in Columbus, Ohio. If for some reason you can not participate, the 1st. runner up Queen will .**
10. **Scholarship:** The Dairy, Pork Producers, Williams Co. Ag Society and other contributors are sponsoring this event and would like all candidates to be able to further your Education/Career. This is one time event each year and for candidates only.
